4/5/6 to 42nd or 59th St or 6 to 51st, B/D/F/V to Rockefeller Center

Things to Do

- **The Plaza Hotel, Apple Store, FAO Schwarz** (closed)
- **Shopping** down 5th Avenue, (Tiffany, Cartier, Henri Bendel) – start at 59th and work your way down to Rockefeller Center, shop the whole way.
- **Museum of Modern Art (MoMA, 11 W 53rd, 5th/6th Aves)** - \$25 adult; \$18 seniors; \$14 students; children 16 and under free.
- **Rockefeller Center** – Top of the Rock, NBC Studios, American Girl Place, Nintendo, Ice Skating. 47th-50th along 5th Ave
- **St. Patrick’s Cathedral** (5th Ave, 50th St)
- **Radio City Music Hall** (1260 6th Ave, 50th/51st)
- **Dylan’s Candy Bar** (60th and 3rd Ave) – world’s largest candy store, owned by Dylan Lauren (Ralph’s daughter)
- **Paley Center for Media (Television & Radio Museum, 52nd, 5th/6th Aves)**. Closed Mon/Tues. \$10 adult, \$5 children suggested.
- **Grand Central Terminal** (42nd/ Lex) – free tours, Whispering Gallery, gorgeous ceiling
- **Bryant Park, New York Public Library**

Restaurants

- **Tao** (58th, Park and Mad) - Asian hot spot with a 16 ft Buddha, gorgeous decor and lots of fun. You may have seen it on a Sex and the City episode.
- **Del Frisco’s Steakhouse** - 1221 6th Ave (49th St)
- **Serendipity** - (225 E 60th, 2nd/3rd Aves) - Best known for Frozen Hot Chocolate, one of Oprah’s favorites
- **The Modern** (and others in MoMA)
- **Pescatore** - (957 2nd Ave at 50th) - Italian, seafood. 2nd floor balcony

Shopping

- **Bergdorf Goodman** (754 5th Ave, 57th/58th)
- **Henri Bendel** (712 5th Ave, 55th/56th)
- **Barney’s New York** (660 Madison Ave, 60th/61st)
- **Saks Fifth Avenue** (611 5th Ave, 49th/50th)
- **Bloomingdales** (1000 3rd Ave, 60th/61st)
- All department stores, and beautiful “holiday lights” tour and window displays during December.

Hotels

- Waldorf Astoria – 301 Park Ave (49th/50th)
- W New York – 541 Lexington Ave (49th)
- New York Marriott East Side – 525 Lexington Ave (48th/49th)
- Roosevelt Hotel – 45 E 45th (Madison Ave)
- Library Hotel – 41st and Madison, great roof deck, themed rooms
