### Things to Do

- **Metropolitan Museum of Art** (1000 5<sup>th</sup> Ave, 82<sup>nd</sup> St) - more than 2 million works of art spanning 5,000 years of world culture. Suggested: \$25; \$17, 65+, \$12 students, under 12 free; Closed Mon. Fri/Sat night, 6-8 pm, classical string quartet above the Great Hall and definitely try and see the roof view in summer, overlooking Central Park.
- **Guggenheim Museum** (1071 5<sup>th</sup> Ave, 89<sup>th</sup>) – the building itself is an architectural icon, exhibitions of modern and contemporary art \$18, closed Thurs.
- **Museum Mile** (5<sup>th</sup> Ave, 82<sup>nd</sup> to 105<sup>th</sup> Streets) - **Frick Collection** (1 E 70<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> Ave), **Jewish Museum** (1109 5<sup>th</sup> Ave, 92<sup>nd</sup>/93<sup>rd</sup>), **Cooper-Hewitt National Design Museum** (2 E 91<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> Ave).
- **Gracie Mansion**, the mayoral abode (except for Mayor Bloomberg), a historic house on 88<sup>th</sup> and East End Ave, overlooking the East River and surrounded by a waterfront park.

### Restaurants

- **Papaya King** (86<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave)– grab a hot dog at the famous NYC institution
- **Big Daddy's** (1596 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, 83<sup>rd</sup>) – casual, burgers, shakes, tater tots and fries. Balloons, wall murals, lunch boxes. Great for kids.
- **Uva Wine Bar** (1486 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, 77<sup>th</sup> St) – small, quaint, good tapas.
- **Café Boulud** (20 76<sup>th</sup>, Madison Ave) – sister restaurant to top-rated French, Daniel (65<sup>th</sup> & Mad). Less expensive, but not cheap. Jackets recommended for men.
- **B. Café** (240 E 75<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Ave) – Belgian bistro with great mussels, fries and beer, outdoor garden in summer.
- Thousands more restaurants on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Aves, 50s to 90s Sts.

### Shopping

- **Madison Ave** (58<sup>th</sup> to 88<sup>th</sup>) – Bottega Veneta, Chanel, Chloe, Christian Louboutin, Dolce & Gabbana, Gianni Versace, Giorgio Armani, Jimmy Choo, La Perla, Prada and dozens more high-end designer stores and local boutiques.
- **Boutiques** – more unique and local flavor along 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave in the 70s, lots of children's, tween, teen and adult stores.
- **INA** (208 73<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Ave), **Designer Resale** (324 E 81<sup>st</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Aves) are two great designer resale shops (the Madison Ave shoppers who wear things once, if at all, and sell or donate them).
